### 2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Will be displayed on the club noticeboard.

### 4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the club flagpole.

4.2 When flag AP  is displayed ashore the first warning signal will be made not less than **60 minutes** minutes after the flag is removed.

4.3 Boats shall not leave the BSC pontoon until advised by the safety crews.

6 races are scheduled, the intention is that there will be no more than 3 races a day. However, additional races may be sailed either in advance or arrears in order to complete the programme if the race committee so decides.

On the last scheduled day of racing (Sunday April 14<sup>th</sup>) no warning signal will be made after 14.00pm

**NB – in the event of the racing taking place in The River Roach we are expecting to launch 1 hour prior to the first warning signal**

### 8. RACING AREAS

Racing will be held on the Rivers Crouch & Roach and will be described at the competitors briefing.

### 9. COURSES

9.2 The courses will be displayed in the clubhouse and will also be presented at the competitors briefing.

### 10. MARKS

10.1 The colour and shape of all course marks will be confirmed at the competitors' briefing and also posted on the official notice board.

10.2 Starting marks will be the race committee signal boat flying an orange flag at the starboard end and a boat or buoy at the port end

10.3 Finishing marks will be the race committee signal boat flying a blue flag at the starboard end, and a boat or buoy at the port end.

### 17. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

17.2 Protest forms are available clubhouse

17.3 the protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has returned to shore after the last race of the day or 30 minutes after flag AP over A is displayed ashore.

## **19. SAFETY**

Burnham Sailing Club will be operating a tally system for this event.

## **20. SUPPORT BOATS**

All support boats shall register at registration and comply with local and event regulations.

Each support boat shall carry a VHF radio and should also carry a mobile phone, call sign and telephone number to be advised to the event Safety Officer

The VHF channel used on the racing area will be advised at the competitors briefing

Kill cords shall be worn whilst engines are running, the course safety officer will be looking out for compliance on this issue, there are no excuses and boats may be requested to leave the race area immediately if kill cords are not being used appropriately.

The official event photographer may move between the starting line and course marks in order to photograph the event, this boat will display a distinguishing flag.

## **Club Specific Information**

**Burnham Sailing Club, The Quay, Burnham on Crouch CM0 8AS**
